A "yes/for" vote on any ballot question is a vote in favor of changing current law or existing circumstances, and a "no/against" vote on any ballot question is a vote against changing current law or existing circumstances.

SHALL HAXTUN SCHOOL DISTRICT RE-2J DEBT BE INCREASED UP TO \$5.895.000. WITH A REPAYMENT COST OF UP TO \$11,900,000 AND SHALL DISTRICT TAXES BE INCREASED BY UP TO \$570,000 ANNUALLY, WITH THE INCREASE IN DEBT TO OCCUR ONLY IF THE DISTRICT RECEIVES "BEST" GRANT AWARDS EXCEEDING THE REQUIRED DISTRICT MATCH (WHICH GRANTS ARE NOT REQUIRED TO BE REPAID) FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING, CONSTRUCTING, IMPROVING AND REPAIRING DISTRICT CAPITAL ASSETS IN ORDER TO RESOLVE BUILDING DEFICIENCIES, SAFETY AND SECURITY CONCERNS, AND OPERATIONAL CHALLENGES, SUCH IMPROVEMENTS INCLUDING, AMONG OTHER THINGS AND AS FUNDS ARE AVAILABLE:

-RENOVATIONS AND ADDITIONS TO CLASSROOMS, THE VOCATIONAL AGRICULTURE AND CAREER TECHNOLOGY EDUCATION LEARNING SPACES, THE ELEMENTARY/AUXILIARY GYM, THE LOCKER ROOMS, AND THE WEIGHT ROOM, INCLUDING RELATED DEMOLITION AS NECESSARY:

WHICH DEBT SHALL CONSIST OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS TO BEAR INTEREST. MATURE, BE SUBJECT TO REDEMPTION, WITH OR WITHOUT PREMIUM, AND BE ISSUED AT SUCH TIME, AT SUCH PRICE (AT, ABOVE OR BELOW PAR) AND IN SUCH MANNER AND CONTAINING SUCH TERMS, CONSISTENT WITH THIS BALLOT ISSUE, AS THE BOARD OF EDUCATION MAY DETERMINE; AND SHALL AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAXES BE LEVIED WITHOUT LIMIT AS TO THE MILL RATE TO GENERATE AMOUNTS. NOT TO EXCEED THE AMOUNTS SET FORTH ABOVE, SUFFICIENT IN EACH YEAR TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON THE BONDS AND TO FUND ANY RESERVES FOR THE PAYMENT THEREOF?


