## SEDGWICK COUNTY COMMISSIONER REGULAR BOARD MEETING APRIL 20, 2021

Meeting was called to order by Chairman Donald Schneider, Mark Turner, Howard McCormick and Christy Beckman in office.

McCormick moved to approve the agenda with the addition of Landfill trash, ambulance collections, legislation and broadband under reports. Turner second, carried.

McCormick moved to approve the April 20, 2021 vouchers as presented. Schneider second, carried.

The minutes of the April 12, 2021 meeting were reviewed. Turner moved to approve the minutes as presented. Schneider second, carried.

The Ambulance collections report was reviewed.

Schneider told the Board that two complaints were received that trash from the Landfill was blowing into adjoining fields. The Board knows that this is an issue and are looking into resolving it.

Schneider reported on the COVID Task Force Meeting. There are two new COVID cases and 7 active in the county. Discussion was held on the possibility of a resolution for the mask mandate since other counties have been doing this, however, a resolution may not be necessary and McCormick expressed his concerns that these resolutions cost taxpayers because of attorney fees, etc. for something the Governor could overturn.

Discussion was held on Referendum 16, Pause Bill. The Board would like to note again, that they are opposed to this bill.

Carl Britton, Sheriff, joined the meeting. Britton told the Board that he is finalizing the details for the four deputies from Yuma County. Britton presented an MOU for review. McCormick moved to approve the MOU between Sedgwick County and Yuma County. Turner second, carried. As per Britton's request, McCormick moved to approve the hiring in temporary positions of William Janisch, Clayton Rockwell, Tracy Combs and Trevor Buchanan at 40 hours per week to fill in while the Sheriff's office is short. Britton left the meeting.

McCormick moved to approve Investment Resolution #2021-015 for Points West Community Bank in the amount of \$100,000 at .10% interest for six months. Turner second, carried.

Tasha Thode, Human Services, joined the meeting. Turner moved to approve the April 20, 2021 agenda as amended. McCormick second, carried. McCormick moved to approve the March 16, 2021 minutes as presented. Turner second, carried. The Board reviewed the February financial reports. Thode's payroll vouchers were approved. Thode presented the petty cash report. McCormick moved to approve the 2020 petty cash report. Turner second, carried. Thode reported that they received the 2020 CSTAT award. The Board praised Thode for this honor especially with a completely new and young staff and new director. Thode left the meeting.
