Cameron Britton, Building Maintenance, joined the meeting. Britton updated the Board on current projects including having cleaning projects for high school students. Britton left the meeting.


Rob Crowder, Civil Defense, joined the meeting. Crowder updated the Board on current projects. Crowder left the meeting.


It is 9:20 a.m. and the Board will go into recess.
