Turner moved to approve Investment Resolution #2022-024 for Points West Community Bank in the amount of \$250,000. McCormick second, carried.


Turner moved to approve Investment Resolution #2022-025 for Points West Community Bank in the amount of \$250,000. McCormick second, carried.

The ballot language for the lodging tax increase was reviewed. The Board will have the attorney make some amendments and will approve next week.


Schneider moved to approve the hiring of Dalton Carlson as a CPR driver for ambulance. Turner second, carried.
