

SEDGWICK COUNTY COMMISSIONER
REGULAR BOARD MEETING
MARCH 27, 2020

Meeting was called to order under the Emergency Meeting Act by Chairman Donald Schneider with Howard McCormick, Mark Turner and Carlton Britton by phone, and Christy Beckman.

McCormick moved to the Agenda as presented. Turner second, carried.

Discussion was held on a measure to ease interest and late fees on property taxes for local businesses that have been subjected to close due to the Governors orders. The interest rate will be .083% (1% per year as opposed to per month). McCormick moved to approve the real estate property interest tax waiver for the businesses affected by the COVID-19 Virus. Turner second, carried.

Schneider gave an update on the COVID-19 Virus. The Board re-iterated that the employees who are still working need to follow the CDC guidelines and they need to stay home if they are not feeling well and will be required to stay home for 14 days.

The Board agreed to send a letter to the employees who have been sent home due to sickness for 14 days.


Britton brought up discussion about obtaining lap tops with the COVID-19 reimbursement program offered. The laptops will give the Sheriff's office the capability to run live while off site. McCormick moved to approve the purchase of two laptops for a cost of \$2,692.73. Turner second carried.

McCormick moved to approve the COVID-19 update letter that was sent to employees. Turner second, carried.

McCormick moved to adjourn the meeting. Turner second, carried.
