MAY 30, 2024

McCormick moved to approve a budgeted donation to the Ovid Fire Department for Ovid Days in the amount of \$450. Berges second, carried.


Schnieder moved to approve a letter of support for Highline Electric for the microwave upgrade and security project. Berges second, carried.
