REGULAR BOARD MEETING  
NOVEMBER 29, 2022

Meeting was called to order by Chairman Donald Schneider with Howard McCormick, Mark Turner, and Christy Beckman present in office. Ron Berges joined in office and Vickie Sandlin, Julesburg Advocate, joined the meeting via zoom.

McCormick moved to approve the agenda as presented. Turner second, carried.

The November 29, 2022 payables and payroll were reviewed. McCormick moved to approve the November 29, 2022 payables as presented. Turner second, carried.

Turner moved to approve the November 22, 2022 minutes as presented. Schneider second, carried.

McCormick reported that Tracy Kizer is getting figures on sprayers to present at a future meeting.

Will Arthur, Attentive, joined the meeting to give the Board a presentation on supplemental insurance. Charlene Turner joined the meeting. The Board will take things into consideration before making a decision. Arthur left the meeting.


Dan Pederson, Accountant, Bridget Britton, Communication Center, Rob Crowder, Civil Defense and Tasha Harris, Ambulance, joined the meeting. Discussion was held on the 2023 budget. Pederson and Turner left the meeting.

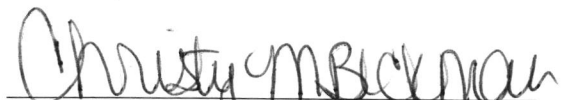
Bridget Britton told the Board that the Governor signed an executive order that expands the COVID order to include no transport denials for RSV, Influenza and other respiratory illnesses and insurance will pay for these. Turner moved to approve the contract between Sedgwick County and State of Colorado Executive Order D-2022044, referencing 22 E18 and 22 E19. Schneider second, carried. Britton and Harris left the meeting.

Rob Crowder updated the Board on current projects including bird flu. There are quite a few dead geese here in the county so Crowder will push out some information to our community. Crowder then asked the Board if he can sign Josilyn up for the EMPG academy. The Board told Crowder to go ahead and sign her up. Crowder asked permission to use capital outlay funds for a laptop for himself and Josilyn with some of the expenses being reimbursed by the state. The Board agreed to the purchase. Crowder left the meeting.
