

SEDGWICK COUNTY COMMISSIONER  
REGULAR BOARD MEETING  
NOVEMBER 29, 2023

Meeting was called to order by Pro-Tem Chairman Howard McCormick with Ronald Berges and Christy Beckman present. Donald Schneider had an excused absence. Vickie Sandlin, Julesburg Advocate, joined the meeting.

Berges moved to approve the agenda with the addition of a request from Concentrics. McCormick second as amended, carried.

McCormick moved to approve the November 29, 2023, vouchers and payroll as presented. Berges second, carried.


Berges moved to approve the November 21, 2023, minutes as presented. McCormick second, carried.


Discussion was held on the Explore Ad request from an earlier meeting. The lodging tax fund has over \$11,000. McCormick moved to approve the Explore Ad in the amount of \$1,500. Berges second, carried.

McCormick told the Board that there was a request from Concentrics to replace the sheriff's concealed weapons permit computer as it was not working and aged out. McCormick moved to approve the purchase of a new concealed weapons computer in the amount of \$1,384.40 to be paid out of the capital outlay line in the Sheriff's budget. Berges second, carried. Discussion was then held about a laptop that Economic Development purchased because they were in immediate need of it, but then never used it and the now immediate need for one in the Treasurer's office. McCormick approved to have Concentrics set it up for the Treasurer and to have finance adjust the budget lines to reflect the purchase out of the Treasurers fund instead of the Economic Development fund.

McCormick reported that the state's decrease in residential property taxes that may have had an adverse impact on the county financially, will not have that impact after all due to the backfill that the state will provide.

Berges moved to adjourn the meeting. McCormick second, carried. The meeting was adjourned.
