REGULAR BOARD MEETING
NOVEMBER 9, 2020

Meeting was called to order by Chairman Donald Schneider with Mark Turner, Howard McCormick and Christy Beckman present. Vickie Sandlin, Julesburg Advocate, joined the meeting via zoom.

Turner moved to approve the agenda with the addition COVID Task Force report, Chamber Meeting report, Julesburg Cemetery update and fairground/exhibit building update and change Dan Pederson to work session. McCormick second, carried.

The November 9, 2020 payables were reviewed. Schneider moved to approve the November 9, 2020 payables. McCormick second, carried.

The minutes of the October 29, 2020 meeting were reviewed. Turner moved to approve the minutes as presented. McCormick second, carried.

The Treasurer's October Financial Report was reviewed.
