Meeting was called to order by Chairman Donald Schneider with Howard McCormick, Ronald Berges and Christy Beckman present. The Assessors Office, Finance Office, R&B Office, Communication Center, Treasurer's Office, Extension Office and Vickie Sandlin, Julesburg Advocate, joined the meeting via zoom.

McCormick moved to approve the agenda with the addition of adding the Italian Caves gravel pit under New Business. Berges second, carried.

McCormick moved to approve the October 17, 2023, vouchers as presented. Berges second, carried.

McCormick moved to approve the October 10, 2023, minutes as presented. Schneider second, carried.

Schnieder moved to approve the removal of Bridget Britton from the NCRETAC Board and the addition of Rob Crowder to the NCRETAC Board. Berges second, carried.

Discussion was held on the Italian Cave mining permit. McCormick suggested extending the permit for one year. Berges moved to approve the extension of the Italian Caves mining permit for 1 year. Schneider second, carried.

Thode said she would not do that as they should not have that kind of liability and do not have training for that type of service and said if anyone comes who is in crisis, Thode and/or her staff will call 9-11.
