REGULAR BOARD MEETING  
OCTOBER 20, 2020

Meeting was called to order by Chairman Donald Schneider with Howard McCormick, Mark Turner and Christy Beckman in office. Vickie Sandlin, Julesburg Advocate, joined the meeting via zoom.

Turner moved to approve the agenda with the addition of report on the COVID Task Force meeting and new hire in Human Services. McCormick second, carried.

Schneider moved to approve the Oct 20, 2020 vouchers as presented. McCormick second, carried.

The minutes of the October 14, 2020 meeting were reviewed. Schneider moved to approve the minutes as presented. McCormick second, carried.


The Board reviewed the new wage scale. This is a work in process and the Board will give the numbers to Dan Pederson, accountant, to see how this will work in the budget


