REGULAR BOARD MEETING  
OCTOBER 30, 2024

Meeting was called to order by Chairman Howard McCormick with Donald Schneider (by phone), Ronald Berges and Christy Beckman present. Lori Ehmke, Heather Foley, Catie Green, Josilyn Lutze and John Fryar joined the meeting.

McCormick moved to approve the agenda with the addition of CTC request under new business. Berges second, carried.

McCormick moved to approve the October 30, 2024 payroll and payables. Berges second, carried.

Schneider moved to approve the October 22, 2024 minutes as presented. Berges second, carried.

Berges reported on the Northeast Colorado Health Board and they are doing water inspections for the NE Colorado counties. Julesburg was cited for lack of a report but there are no infectious diseases reported.

Josilyn Lutze, Extension, joined the meeting and gave the Board her letter of resignation. McCormick thanked Lutze for her service to the county. Berges moved to accept the resignation of Josilyn Lutze. McCormick second, carried.

Gib Becker, B&B Erectors, joined the meeting. Becker was asked to be the GC for a project and the Julesburg School for a 30 x 60 greenhouse. Becker is looking to save the high school some money and is asking the Board for an in-kind donation of 500 yards of fill. McCormick told Becker that this is a big ask of the county as that equates to 30 semi's of fill. McCormick asked if he would be getting the concrete locally to which Becker responded yes. The Board told Becker they will talk to Bob Coty at Road & Bridge for more details before making a decision. Becker left the meeting.

Katie asked the Board for a work session to discuss filling the Extension Office position.

It is now 8:54 and the meeting has re-convened.


