Bucket Calf & Bottle Lamb & Goat Show

Superintendents: Bucket Calf: Steven Wahrman Bottle Lamb: Rhonda Graham Bottle Goat: Rhonda Graham

The purpose of this event is to help children understand all the responsibilities of raising a farm animal. The calf/lamb/goat must be halter broke and checked for sickness; fed twice daily, watered, and the pen cleaned. The child must have parental involvement to achieve a successful learning experience. This is not a sanctioned 4-H project and is sponsored completely by the Sedgwick County Fair Board.

Rules:

1. The Bucket Calf and Bottle Lamb/Goat Show will be open to all youth up through 7 years of age. Must be no older than 7 years of age as of January 1.

2. You will need to contact your species superintendent or the Extension Office no later than Friday, July 29th if you plan on bringing a bucket/bottle animal to allow for pen assignments.

3. See Beef, Sheep, and Goat General Rules Section of this fair book. All animals must be vet checked before they are permitted to stall.

4. All bucket/bottle animals must be brought in from 2:00 to 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, August 3rd, 2022.

5. May exhibit only one calf and/or one lamb/goat.

6. Judging will focus on the child's ability to handle the calf/lamb/goat.

7. The Superintendent will assign all calves, lambs and goats to a specified area to be stalled.

8. Calves, lambs and goats must be on a halter for show.

9. Participants will receive participation ribbons.

10. All bucket and bottle animals must be 9 months of age or younger.

Sedgwick County Fair Mutton Bustin' Application and Liability Form

Mutton Bustin' tests the ability of young cowboys and cowgirls by putting them on the back of a sheep and holding on for dear life. The sheep are loaded into a small chute. The rider, wearing a Northeast Colorado Health Department approved helmet, climbs on the sheep and grabs onto its wool. The chute is opened and the sheep runs into the arena with the competitor hanging on for as long as possible. All cowboys and cowgirls receive a reward for their participation.

Mutton Bustin' will take place Saturday after the catch-it contest in the indoor arena.
